

Canada's 150th Anniversary Celebrations ARNPEI's Invitation for Nominations

ARNPEI is inviting nominations from the membership for CNA's Canada's 150th anniversary celebrations.

In celebration of Canada's 150th anniversary CNA is honoring nurses from across Canada. ARNPEI can submit 5 RNs for consideration of receiving a Canada 150 award. CNA will be acknowledging the nurses selected across the country in a feature Article the July/August edition of the Canadian Nurse Journal. The article will include a web-based phot album highlighting 150 of Canada's who are impacting health care and the health care system in Canada.

The selection criteria include:

- Demonstrated leadership in connecting with patients and their families ad advanced patient-centered approach through traditional or innovative methods
- Inspired a passion for nursing
- Been a strong public advocate and active leader in support of social justice and quality health care
- Enhanced and/or promoted exemplary and innovative nursing practice
- Advanced professional expertise and interprofessional practice
- Contributed significantly to professional organizations, inspiring and supporting the professional development of others by serving as a mentor or advisor

Submissions Format includes a biographical description (75-100 characters which is the maximum, including spaces) and image format described below:

(a) Biographical description - Complete name with license designation (RN; NP; retired RN). Example - Barb Langlois RN: Barb has worked in health care as a communication, conflict and personal wellness expert. That means she helps people be better at what they do, whether it's creating positive workplaces, having difficult conversations or trying to balance out their life. Barb's messages are always delivered in a fun, engaging and down-to-earth style. She is also a published author, with articles appearing in professional nursing journals and health and wellness magazines.

(b) Image Forma - Images should have a portrait orientation. Backgrounds could include a landscape or other key images that the honoree identifies with. Example – a BC nurse may want to have the image of Whistler in the background. Image resolution must be 300 dpi at 100 percent size (600 x 900 pixels).
